**WELCOME**

**HYMN 605** "Father Welcomes"

**Pastor:** In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

**People:** **Amen.**

**Pastor:** Dearly beloved, Christ our Lord says in the last chapter of Matthew, "Go, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." In the last chapter of Mark Jesus says, "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved." The apostle Peter adds, "Baptism now saves us."

In order to fulfill the command of Christ, and to bestow the blessings of Baptism on these children, we are gathered here with water and the Word to receive these children into God's Kingdom of Grace through this Holy Sacrament.

*To the parents:* How are these children to be named?

**Parents:** ***Siena Grace and Capri Ella.***

**Pastor:** Receive the sign of the holy cross both upon your forehead and upon your heart to mark you as one redeemed by Christ the crucified.

Let us all pray together:

**All:** **Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name, Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven; give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.**

**Pastor:** The Lord preserve your coming in and your going out from this time forth and even forevermore.

**Pastor:** Since ancient times the Church has observed the custom of appointing sponsors for children who are baptized. It is the duty of sponsors to witness the Baptism, and, as the children grow, to remind them of it. They are to pray for the children and support them as they grow in their faith. They are to serve as examples to them.

Pastor: Sponsors, is it your intention to fulfill these responsibilities to the best of your ability? Then say, "Yes, with the help of God."

**Sponsors: Yes, with the help of God.**

Pastor: God enable you both to will and to do this faithful and loving work and with His grace fulfill what we are unable to do.

Let us now join our hearts and voices with parents and sponsors to confess our faith in the Triune God into whose name these children are to be baptized, using the words of the Apostolic Creed:

**All: I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.**

**And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilot, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead.**

**I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.**

Pastor: I shall now ask parents and sponsors, and the members of the congregation in memory of their own baptisms, to answer the questions I shall now address to the children:

Pastor: Do you renounce the devil and all his works and all his ways? Then say, "I do renounce them."

**All: I do renounce them.**

Pastor: Do you believe in the Triune God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit? Then say "I believe."

**All: I believe.**

Pastor: Do you desire to be baptized? Then say, "Yes, I do."

**All: Yes, I do.**

Pastor: Siena Grace, Capri Ella, I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

May God, the Father of our Lord, Jesus Christ, who has begotten you of water and the Spirit keep you in your baptismal grace until your life's end. Amen.

Pastor: Let us pray. Almighty and most merciful God and Father, we thank and praise You that you graciously preserve and enlarge your family, and have granted Siena and Capri the new birth in Holy Baptism, and have made them members of Your Son, our Lord, Jesus Christ and heirs of Your heavenly kingdom. Keep them in their baptismal grace that they may grow to lead Godly lives and finally, with all Your saints, obtain the promised inheritance in heaven, through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.

Pastor: Peace be with you. Amen.

**Duet "Borning Cry"**

Pastor: Alleluia! Christ is risen!

**Pastor:** Almighty God, our heavenly Father,

**People:** We confess that we are by nature sinful and unclean. We have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed, by the things we have done and by what we have failed to do. We have not honored You as we ought, nor have we served others in love. We deserve to be cast from Your presence forever. Yet in Your great mercy, You sent Your Son to die and rise again for us. Help us to know the power of His resurrection and to share in the joy that His forgiveness brings. Enable us to receive Your mercy and be renewed by Your Spirit that we may honor You as the Lord and God in whom we place our trust. Amen.

**Pastor:** Almighty God, our heavenly Father, hears our prayers and answers them for the sake of His Son, Jesus Christ. By faith, we stand at His cross and empty tomb. We find our refuge and sing for joy in the shadow of His wings. As a called and ordained servant of Christ, and by His authority, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

**People:** Amen.

**Pastor:** Alleluia! Christ is risen!

**Pastor:** The Holy Gospel according to St. John, the twentieth chapter.

**People:** Glory to You, O Lord.

<sup>19</sup> On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, the doors being locked where the disciples were for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." <sup>20</sup> When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. <sup>21</sup> Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I am sending you." <sup>22</sup> And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. <sup>23</sup> If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you withhold forgiveness from any, it is withheld."

<sup>24</sup> Now Thomas, one of the Twelve, called the Twin, was not with them when Jesus came.

<sup>25</sup> So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see in his hands the mark of the nails, and place my finger into the mark of the nails, and place my hand into his side, I will never believe." <sup>26</sup> Eight days later, his disciples were inside again, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." <sup>27</sup> Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here, and see my hands; and put out your hand, and place it in my side. Do not disbelieve, but believe." <sup>28</sup> Thomas answered him, "My Lord and my God!" <sup>29</sup> Jesus said to him, "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." <sup>30</sup> Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; <sup>31</sup> but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

**Pastor:** This is the Gospel of the Lord.

**People:** Praise to You, O Christ.
