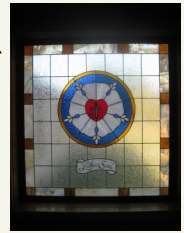

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 6. Lent is wonderful time for each of us to pause from our normal routine and ponder again what our Savior has accomplished for each of us with His suffering, death and resurrection. This year we will have two sermon series during Lent.

#### Mid-Week Services

The theme for our Mid-Week Services is **Signs of Lent**. Just as we see signs along the road while driving which tell us what to do or what to expect; so, God through His Word gives us signs to direct us to our Savior and guide us in our lives. Each of the services will focus on a different sign which can serve as a reminder of a direction God gives us in His Word. The services and themes are:
